In this study 182 families had been selected. This study has been revealed that families are not aware related to the aganbadi government schemes and who parents are become knowledgeable by Aganbadi worker, N.G.O. and aganbadi helper and good friends like; ANM.

Community based management scheme is related to the malnourished child's reports scheme. Malnourished low weight child we can make normal healthy child by continuous care. In all over world community based management of malnourished child reports shows that it is a good way, if considered these 3 points:

1. Home based diet food which includes all the food nutrients.

2. Essential hospital treatment for serious malnourished Childs.

3. To study the growth of serious malnourished child. And to continue educate the parents for nutrition education.

Madhavi and et, al. (2008); According to Madhavi and et, al. find out their study that Role of integral management in childhood disease and to change child behavior. This study is based on Navajatan government Scheme conducted by the women and child development program. 'Navajatan'



government scheme started in complete whole state to free from child malnutrition. In 'Navajatan'scheme add the aganbadi and families to keep away malnutrition from the state. Management of community development for malnourished child special capacity has been developed. Under this scheme 9 village Jury council have been started. In this scheme 340 village jury, 231 well-nourished ANM friends, 427 self-help-groups, and 51 volunteer-groups targeted to the 22345 malnourished children. In year 2005-06() rate of malnutrition was 47.1%. And in 2015 it will become 30 percent.

Shashi and Annapoorna(2012); According to this study for consolidated child development a study service has been described. Under this consolidated child development scheme the government program and scheme has been studied for India's nutrition and health problems solutions. Estimation of nutrition and health service awareness between aganbadi

workers this study has been organized.

OBJECTIVES

To study the schemes and program for community development running by the government.

MATERIALS & METHODS:

This study has been conducted in Raipur city and included 182 families. And in this study lottery sampling method has been used. The research is based on Interview and questionnaire method.

Table: 1 revealed that about chief minister child reference scheme 92.30 percent

From the table 2 about chief minister child reference scheme 83 percent parents from ANM worker, 11 percent parents from female helper, 4 percent parents from NGO, and 2 percent parents from well-nourished friends worker getting knowledge and information.

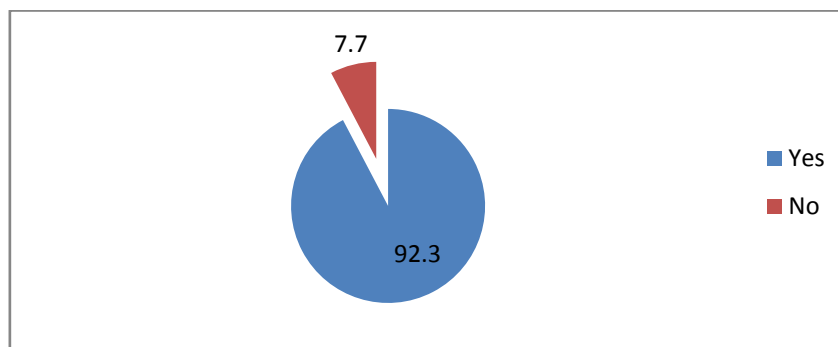
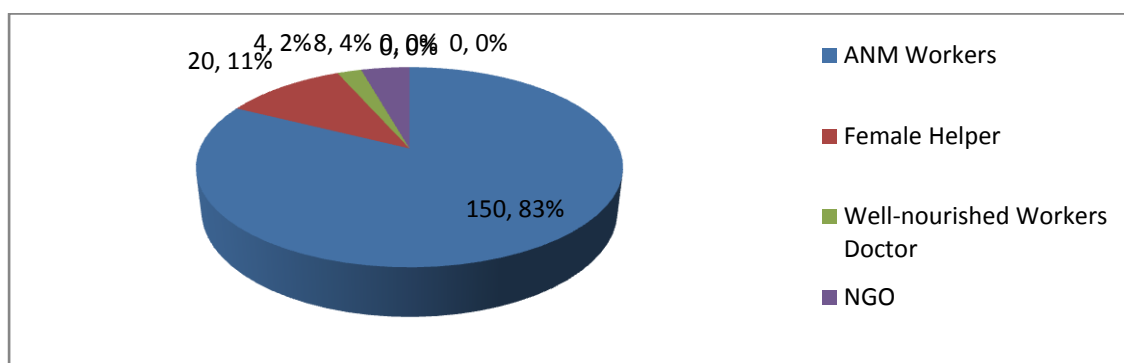
